

Troubleshooting

- > Turn off your internet by either turning off your mobile connection, or turn airplane mode on, then reactivate your WiFi
- > If problems still persist go back to Step 1 and check where the WiFi is connecting. Turn-off 'autoconnect' to other devices and try again.









Operational Notes

EC/TDS probe (range 0.1 – 5.0EC / 50 – 2500TDS)

Very low readings (~0.1EC / 50TDS or lower) will make LazyGrow detect the probe is out of the water. If using demineralised water or very clean water, you may need to add a little of each nutrient to kickstart the nutrient additions and pH adjustments.

Very high or low EC/TDS readings, will give an alarm after a period of time.

pH adjustment additions

These occurs every second hour:

- pH measurement happens ~50 minutes, before adjustment
- pH adjustment at ~50 minutes

Then no additions for the following hour to allow recirculation and mixing of your system.

If over adjustment occurs, lower your pH adjustment amount in reservoir system data.

Nutrient additions

These occurs every second hour:

- Nutrient A at ~5 minutes
- Nutrient B at ~10 minutes
- Nutrient C at ~15 minutes

Then no additions for the following hour to allow recirculation and mixing of your system.

Each nutrient is added with the ratio given in your Growth Stage. You can have up to 20 growth stages.

The method of addition to achieve high addition, must use your system data. Each addition is targeting 0-25% of the requirement for the reservoir system size. When the EC/TDS is far from you target, 25% is the amount. When close to your target LazyGrow will aim to hit your target.

Overshooting/Undershooting your target EC/TDS by a small amount is most likely from the reservoir water amount being slightly different.

Overshooting/Undershooting your target EC/TDS by large amounts might be due to the nutrient strength being different.

Solution to *Overshooting* your target EC/TDS is to increase your reservoir size OR decrease the nutrient ratio in your Growth Stage.

Solution to *Undershooting* your target EC/TDS is to decrease your reservoir size OR increase the nutrient ratio in your Growth Stage.





Operational Notes

pH probe (range 2 - 12)

pH probes are very sensitive to other electrical source. LazyGrow has separated from the system reservoir to prevent pH reading errors. The added benefit of this separation is also increased the life and longevity of the pH probe. It is important that pH box water is not connected to the water in the reservoir, so the return pipe must be above the water.

Note: pH targets further away from pH 7 = shorter pH probe life.

Growth Stages 1 to 20

Growth Stages allows you to setup for the entire grow season/cycle of your plant.

- You must set each growth stage.
- If you have only 1 growth stage, input the data for GS_1 and give input duration of 365 days.
- You will need to reset the current day at the start of each crop.

Growth Stage changes occur at midnight between growth stage. At the end of the last day of the current growth stage and the start of the first new day of the next growth stage.

Run-to-Waste

The option to have run-to-waste is for your convenience.

This operates only during the ON and OFF times at evenly space times.

ON time = 7:00 and OFF time = 15:00 means: 10 hours

5 number of times over 10 hours means: Run-to-waste event occurs every 2 hours

The amount of water removed is equal to the percentage of the reservoir divided by the number time you want to run-to-waste.

10% of reservoir means: 100L reservoir x 10% = 10L per day run-towaste

5 number of times means: 10L / 5 = 2L per run-to-waste event

Water Out

The Water Out feature of the Growth Stage is for your convenience and will operate as you set. This operates at any time of the day and can be used in interesting ways, like:

- Empty the reservoir before a new growth stage
- Periodic replacement of the reservoir every few days or several days
- A single nightly run-to-waste cycle

Use it, however you like.


